

RENTAL RATES AND POLICIES

The Studio of The Corning Museum of Glass is available for rental when there are no classes or other events in progress. Rental times must be booked in advance and prepaid with a credit card. Call The Studio or stop in to schedule rental time (607-438-5335 or 607-368-2475)

Cancellations: call the Technicians cellular 368-2475, or if no-one answers, the main office 438-5100.

Prepay *10 - 29 hours = 10% discount:*

Kiln shop rental: \$46, \$67, \$82 per kiln (size) /day; please call for more information.

Hot shop propane torch: \$2.75 / hour in use or on pilot, billed in 1-hour increments.

Notes: Failure to clean up after your rental time will result in a \$50.00 fee.

Failure to cancel scheduled hotshop rental time at least 24 hours in advance will result in a \$80.00 cancellation/no show fee (Cancellations: Main office 607-438-5100 / Tech cell 607-368-2475).

Failure to report propane usage will result in a billing for all hours rented.

Explanation:

- There is no refund for unused prepaid rental time; unused prepaid time expires 2 years from last rental. All rental time must be paid for before beginning to work, or guaranteed with a credit card, excluding extra charges. All bills must be settled within 3 days. Renters must settle any unpaid charges before booking future rentals.
- Hot shop rental includes the use of a glory hole, furnace, pipewarmer, and a shared annealer for an overnight cycle. More than an overnight cycle of annealing: requesting special annealing or specialized door cracking procedures requires additional fees. Rental includes 10 lbs of glass / hour. Glass allowance is weighed, totaled and billed on a per blow slot basis. Prepaying for time does not entitle the user to any more or less glass allowance. Renters are responsible for segregating their glass if they suspect they will go over their allotment or are requested to separate glass on their exit form.
- Lamp shop rental includes the use of one torch and one hand torch.
- Kiln rental includes up to a 24-hour cycle. More than a 24-hour cycle will be billed in 6-hour increments until the work is removed.

All rentals require purchasing blocks of time or paying before you schedule time. Exit forms are available for all rentals and returning them is required for accurate billing and time deductions.
